A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, while adults may use words to communicate, children often rely on play to convey thoughts and feelings that might otherwise not be expressed; and

WHEREAS, play therapy is a form of therapy used to help primarily young children express their thoughts and feelings in a safe environment through play; play therapists use the therapeutic powers of play to help clients prevent or resolve psychosocial difficulties; and

WHEREAS, play therapists are licensed mental health professionals who have earned graduate degrees in the field of mental health, and who, through specialized training and education, may have received specific credentials to become registered play therapists; and

WHEREAS, play therapists may also include marriage and family therapists, psychiatric nurses, psychologists, clinical social workers, and school counselors; and

WHEREAS, through play therapy, these mental health professionals help children describe and manage their behaviors and mental health; and

WHEREAS, the fundamentals of play therapy can help parents, caregivers, and teachers focus on ways to further the personal and social growth of children, and ensure that they have the opportunity to achieve their full potential;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim February 2 – 8, 2020, as "**NATIONAL PLAY THERAPY WEEK**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
