A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, window film manufacturers in the United States contribute to our national economy and employment, and their products are a cost-effective means to help reduce energy consumption and improve public health; and

WHEREAS, window film helps to create more safe and secure environments for homes, vehicles, public buildings, and commercial establishments; and

WHEREAS, window film can prevent dangerous glare and screen against the damaging UV rays that lead to skin cancer; protection against solar glare and skin damage is especially important to the health of commercial drivers who risk long exposure to the sun; and

WHEREAS, the window film industry contributes to a strong economy in North Carolina by reducing energy consumption for residents and businesses, and by creating job opportunities in communities throughout our state; and

WHEREAS, the window film industry is committed to educating the public on the benefits of window film through their nonprofit trade association, the International Window Film Association; and

WHEREAS, National Window Film Day is an opportunity to acknowledge the dedicated professionals who manufacture, distribute, and install window film, and to educate the public about the industry's contributions to our society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2020, as "NATIONAL WINDOW FILM DAY" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
