WHEREAS, problem gambling can have a significant societal and economic cost on individuals, families, businesses, and communities; and

WHEREAS, problem gambling is treatable, and treatment is effective in minimizing the harm caused to both individuals and society; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Education Lottery Problem Gambling Helpline (1-877-718-5543) provides confidential support and resources through the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services in the Department of Health and Human Services to help treat this addiction; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina joins our nation in recognizing Problem Gambling Awareness Month to raise awareness of problem gambling and the free resources available;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim March, 2021, as "PROBLEM GAMBLING AWARENESS MONTH" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
