A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the North Carolina State Capitol Police force is charged with providing a safe and secure environment for employees and visitors to the State Government complex and other state-owned properties entrusted to their care; and

WHEREAS, officers of the State Capitol Police administer federal, state, and local laws using ethical and legal standards; and

WHEREAS, State Capitol Police officers are responsible for conducting investigations of serious crimes, and working with various groups during rallies, demonstrations, and other events to ensure the safety of demonstrators, bystanders, and state property; and

WHEREAS, the State Capitol Police Dispatch Center monitors emergency alarms at state-owned facilities 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and directs emergency responders as needed; and

WHEREAS, the State Capitol Police has provided dedicated service to the people of North Carolina and state officials, employees and visitors for more than 50 years, and has recommitted itself to providing superior public safety services to the public as it seeks national accreditation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 29 – October 6, 2019, as "STATE CAPITOL POLICE OFFICERS' WEEK" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
