REWARD PROCLAMATION

As Governor of North Carolina, the following information has been furnished to me:

On October 8, 2015 at 2:40 a.m., Greensboro Police Officers responded to a single car accident on East Market Street near Holt's Chapel Road in Greensboro. Once on scene, the officers determined that Mr. Michael Lovett was the victim of a shooting and that this shooting caused the accident. At the time of the accident, Mr. Lovett was driving a white in color 2015 BMW 535i. He was transported to a local hospital in critical condition, and passed away on October 10, 2015, from his injuries.

To preserve law and order the person or persons who committed such an infamous crime must be brought to justice.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, under and by virtue of the authority in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 15-53.1, do hereby offer a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Michael Lovett.

The payment of this reward, or any portion thereof, is conditional upon the information being furnished as a direct result of the issuance of this proclamation. The total reward paid to all persons in this case shall not exceed \$5,000.

The reward offered herein does not extend to any law enforcement officer of the State or any political subdivision thereof.

Anyone having information concerning this case should contact the Greensboro/Guilford Crime Stoppers or the State Bureau of Investigation.
