Dear Mr. Fleming:

Under provisions of 13 C.F.R. § 123.3, I respectfully request that the Administrator of the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) implement an administrative declaration to provide assistance in the form of SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loans for the City of Durham, North Carolina, following the April 10, 2019, gas leak that lead to a deadly explosion in the downtown area.

This explosion in the City of Durham located in Durham County, North Carolina consumed an entire city block causing heavy damage to nine businesses, destroying four businesses and impacting the operations of surrounding businesses. At least five businesses in the area have been impacted by this event.

A survey of these affected businesses was conducted to determine the economic impact of their losses, with a cumulative gross economic loss of 40% or more for the disaster period as compared to the same period in the preceding year. Based upon these surveys, I certify that at least five small businesses in the disaster area have suffered substantial economic injury as a result of the disaster and are in need of financial assistance not otherwise available on reasonable terms.
