EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 275

NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 274

WHEREAS, in December 2022, the State of North Carolina was threatened by prolonged cold weather and an increased demand for drivers of propane and other heating fuels; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 274, Declaration of a State of Emergency and Temporary Suspension of Motor Vehicle Regulations to Ensure Adequate Transportation of Fuel Throughout the State, was issued on December 20, 2022; and

WHEREAS, this emergency declaration and transportation waiver is no longer necessary.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, by the power vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of North Carolina, **IT IS ORDERED**:

Executive Order No. 274 is hereby terminated immediately.
