PARDON OF FORGIVENESS ORDER

FOR

FLEMMING TILLMAN RAGAS, SR.

WHEREAS, Flemming Tillman Ragas, Sr., at the January 1999 Term of Cumberland County Superior Court, pled guilty to Felonious Breaking and Entering and Larceny, Docket Number 98CRS029550 and Misdemeanor Possession of Stolen Property, Docket Number 98CRS025701, and was sentenced to a minimum term of six (6) months and a maximum term of eight (8) months in the North Carolina Department of Correction, suspended for eighteen (18) months with probation for eighteen (18) months; and

WHEREAS, Flemming Tillman Ragas, Sr., at the February 1999 Term of Lee County Superior Court, pled guilty to Felonious Possession of Stolen Property, Docket Number 98CRS11074, and was sentenced to a minimum term of six (6) months and a maximum term of eight (8) months in the North Carolina Department of Correction, suspended for thirty-six (36) months with probation for thirty-six (36) months; and


WHEREAS, Flemming Tillman Ragas, Sr. now seeks forgiveness from the Governor, in light of the circumstances surrounding his crimes, his subsequent record and current need; and

WHEREAS, Flemming Tillman Ragas, Sr.'s record since these convictions has been one of responsible civic behavior and community service.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, in consideration of the above factors, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents PARDON the said Flemming Tillman Ragas, Sr., it being a Pardon of Forgiveness. This Pardon shall not apply to any other offenses.
