COMMUTATION ORDER

WHEREAS, BRIAN KEITH FULLER, at the October 1998 Term of Rockingham County Superior Court, was convicted of Second Degree Murder, Docket Number 97CRS5859, and by judgment of said Court was sentenced to a minimum term of two hundred thirty-seven (237) months and a maximum term of two hundred ninety-four (294) months in the custody of the North Carolina Department of Correction; and was convicted of Second Degree Murder, Docket Number 97CRS5860, and by judgment of said Court was sentenced to a consecutive minimum term of two hundred thirty-seven (237) months and a maximum term of two hundred ninety-four (294) months in the custody of the North Carolina Department of Correction; and

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to me that this case is one fit for a Commutation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents COMMUTE his sentence to make him parole eligible subject to the condition that if he is placed on parole, he shall not violate any conditions of his parole or have his parole revoked for any reason.

If the Governor, or his successor, finds that BRIAN KEITH FULLER has violated any condition herein provided, then the Governor or his successor may, in his or her discretion, revoke or modify the Commutation granted this day.

This Commutation Order shall not extend to any other offenses.

This Commutation Order is effective this the 31st day of December 2024.
