WHEREAS, the University of North Carolina's Women's Lacrosse Team has contributed greatly to our state's reputation of excellence in women's lacrosse; and

WHEREAS, since the inception of the team, the University of North Carolina's Women's Lacrosse Team has won three NCAA Championships in 2013, 2016, and 2022; and

WHEREAS, the top-ranked Tar Heels finished the season undefeated with a winning record of 22-0; and

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2022, the team traveled to Homewood Field in Baltimore, Maryland, defeating Boston College to secure their twenty-second win and the NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championship; and

WHEREAS, led by head coach Jenny Levy, the University of North Carolina's Women's Lacrosse Team won the third-most national titles in history, completed the program's first undefeated season, and helped Coach Levy claim her 40th career NCAA Tournament win; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina is proud to recognize this extraordinary team and wish them continued success;
