**WHEREAS**, increasing economic, entrepreneurial, and financial literacy in North Carolina is important in creating a more prosperous future for all North Carolinians;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim October, 2022, as “**ECONOMIC EDUCATION MONTH**” in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
