WHEREAS, first responders maintain safety and order in times of crisis, volunteer in our communities and schools, and are a vital part of every North Carolina community;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim September, 2024, as **"FIRST RESPONDERS APPRECIATION MONTH"** in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
