WHEREAS, research and advancements in medical science are critical to enhancing our understanding of mast cell diseases and developing effective treatments and therapies; and

WHEREAS, a collective effort is needed from healthcare professionals, researchers, policymakers, and the public to provide support, funding, and resources toward raising awareness about mast cell diseases and their impact on individuals and society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 20, 2024, as "MASTOCYTOSIS AND MAST CELL DISEASES AWARENESS DAY" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
