A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, charter schools encourage and engage parents and communities in youth education; and

WHEREAS, charter schools offer a variety of learning environments and emphases, including college-preparedness, career technical education, arts, and STEM; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina joins the North Carolina Association for Public Charter Schools in celebrating the accomplishments and contributions of charter schools to public education;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSH STEIN, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 11-17, 2025, as "**NATIONAL CHARTER SCHOOLS WEEK**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
