A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, National Read Across America Day, established by the National Education Association and now marking its 25th anniversary on March 2, 2023, highlights and celebrates reading; and

WHEREAS, this day is celebrated across America each year, and aims to promote and celebrate reading through special activities and events that showcase the importance of literacy programs that empower and help children, teens, and adults get excited about reading and build a nation of readers; and

WHEREAS, ProLiteracy estimates 43 million adults in the United States cannot read, write, or do basic math at about a 3rd grade level; 14 percent of the adult population cannot read, and by learning to read, individuals can gain self-respect and confidence and strive toward goals that otherwise would not be achievable; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina is committed to increasing literacy by promoting and supporting literacy programs across our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim March 2, 2023, as "**NATIONAL READ ACROSS AMERICA DAY**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
