A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, responsible firearm owners who utilize safe storage devices and practices are critical to preventing firearm-related theft, violence, death, suicide, and injury; and

WHEREAS, 42 percent of North Carolinians keep a firearm in or around their home, and 53 percent of North Carolinians with loaded firearms at home keep them unlocked; and

WHEREAS, firearm violence is one of the most persistent and deadly issues facing North Carolina and the United States; an average of five North Carolinians die per day from a firearm injury, and rates of firearm violence and injury are increasing statewide and nationally; and

WHEREAS, firearm violence presents a statewide crisis in terms of public safety, public health and mental health; 62 percent of all violent deaths in the last 10 years were firearm related; more than half of firearm-related deaths are suicides and American Indians, non-Hispanic white adults, and veterans have higher rates of firearm suicides than the general population; and

WHEREAS, the juvenile mortality rate due to firearm injuries has surpassed motor vehicle crashes as the leading cause of death by injury for children; more than 1,500 juveniles statewide were charged with firearm-related offenses in State fiscal year 2022, with those offenses making up 13 percent of all juvenile crime in the state, and there were 294 instances of school-based offenses involving firearms during the same time period; and

WHEREAS, every North Carolinian who owns a firearm should be encouraged to practice safe storage and responsible firearm ownership; securing a firearm using a safe storage device can prevent theft, violent crime including school shootings, accidental shootings, suicide, and improper use of firearms by youth, thereby creating safer homes and communities; and

WHEREAS, communities that require safe storage report a 59 percent decrease in unintentional deaths due to firearms, and an estimated 32 percent of youth firearm suicide and unintentional death could be prevented through safe storage; and

WHEREAS, the NC S.A.F.E (Secure All Firearms Effectively) initiative, has been established through partnership between the Governor's Office and the North Carolina Department of Public Safety and further informed by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services as a resource to educate North Carolinians on safe storage and responsible firearm ownership;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim June 4 – 10, 2023, as "NORTH CAROLINA S.A.F.E. WEEK OF ACTION" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
