WHEREAS, the Division of Community Supervision is dedicated to protection, innovation and rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina's community supervision officers, and those across the nation, have made the vital commitment to make positive changes in their communities with their dedication, perseverance, and training;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim July 16 – 22, 2023, as "**PROBATION, PAROLE, AND COMMUNITY SUPERVISION OFFICERS' WEEK**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
