WHEREAS, North Carolina lineworkers, part of a long-standing personal, family, and professional tradition, are devoted to service and deserve our respect and appreciation on this and all days;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSH STEIN, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim April 13, 2026, as "**LINWORKER APPRECIATION DAY**" in North Carolina and commend its observance to all residents.
