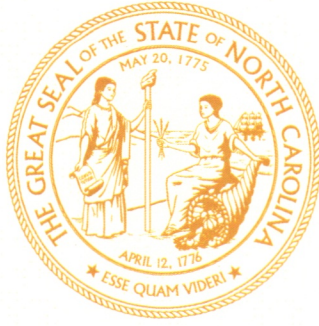

WHEREAS, North Carolina has 170 senior centers in 96 counties serving as focal points for the provision and coordination of a broad spectrum of services and activities for older adults; and

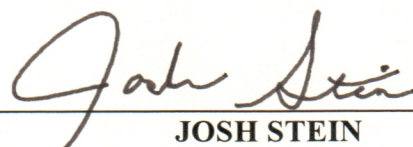
