WHEREAS, North Carolina is proud to be home to nearly 10,000 active-duty and reserve Sailors, as well as the civilian personnel who support the Navy, primarily located at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune; and


WHEREAS, the unofficial mottos of “Semper Fortis” (always strong) and “Non sibi sed patriae” (not for self, but for country) represent the longstanding tradition of our nation’s Sailors to put service before self; and

WHEREAS, in commemoration of the 250th anniversary of the establishment of the United States Navy, North Carolinians proudly recognize and are grateful to the Sailors who served and continue to serve our country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSH STEIN, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 13, 2025, as “**UNITED STATES NAVY BIRTHDAY**” in North Carolina and commend its observance to all citizens.
