COMMUTATION ORDER

KIRSTON MARSHALL ANGELL

WHEREAS, KIRSTON MARSHALL ANGELL ("Angell"), at the January 2007 Term of Davie County Superior Court, was convicted of Second Degree Murder, Docket Number 07CRS000493, and by judgment of said Court was sentenced to a minimum term of two hundred twenty (220) months and a maximum term of two hundred seventy-three (273) months in the custody of the North Carolina Department of Correction; and

WHEREAS, at the April 2015 Term of Davie County Superior Court, the court altered the sentence to a minimum term of one hundred sixty (160) months and a maximum term of two hundred one (201) months; and

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to me that this case is one fit for a Commutation.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents COMMUTE his sentence to make him parole eligible January 1, 2027, subject to the condition that if he is placed on parole supervision, he shall not violate any conditions of his parole supervision or have his parole supervision revoked for any reason. Should Angell be paroled, the term of his parole supervision shall not extend beyond his projected release date pursuant to his current sentence.

If the Governor, or his successor, finds that KIRSTON MARSHALL ANGELL has violated any condition herein provided, then the Governor or his successor may, in his or her discretion, revoke or modify the Commutation granted this day.

This Commutation Order shall not extend to any other offenses.

This Commutation Order effective this the 13th day of November 2024.
