A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, in State Fiscal Year 2020-2021, over \$718 million was collected, providing support for more than 379,000 children; and

WHEREAS, children who do not receive adequate financial and emotional support from their parents may experience greater difficulty in becoming happy, healthy, and productive citizens; and

WHEREAS, many concerned and dedicated judges, district attorneys, clerks of court, sheriffs' personnel, and child support professionals work to establish and enforce child support orders for North Carolina's children, one of our state's most vital resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim August, 2021, as "**CHILD SUPPORT AWARENESS MONTH**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
