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Initiatives for Adult Learners – NC Reconnect

- Each of the 10 colleges are receiving \$50,000 mini-grants from the \$2M for adult learner pilots
- Focus is on returning adults
- Strategies: Inside Track (student recruiting and coaching), centrally coordinated marketing campaign, mini-grants, small cohorts to share learning



Initiatives for Adult Learners – REACH (Racial Equity for Adult Credentials in Higher Education)

- Combined \$840,000 from funders, Lumina Foundation and Belk Endowment, plus \$25,000 mini-grants from State funds for the adult learner pilots
- Focused on adult learners of color and supporting them to complete short-term, high value credentials Goal is a 2% increase in credential attainment for students of color at schools in the consortium



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Longleaf Complete Funds

- \$3.5M
- Near-completers



NC GEER Funds

- \$11M awarded to date
- Short-term workforce training
