COMMUTATION ORDER

FOR

APRIL LEIGH BARBER

WHEREAS, APRIL LEIGH BARBER, at the August, 1992 Term of Wilkes County Superior Court, pled guilty to two counts of First-Degree Murder, Docket Numbers 91-CRS-6424, 91-CRS-6425, and by judgement of said Court was sentenced to two consecutive terms of Life in Prison, in the custody of the then North Carolina Department of Correction; and

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to me that this case is one fit for a Commutation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents **COMMUTE** her sentences to time served subject to the following conditions:

1. She shall not commit any felony, Class A1 misdemeanor, or impaired driving offense under the laws of the United States of America or any of its States or Territories;
2. She shall waive extradition to the State of North Carolina for any State of the United States of America or any of its Territories and will not contest any effort by any State or Territory to return her to the State of North Carolina in the event she violates any conditions of this Commutation Order;
3. She shall report promptly to her assigned community corrections officer when instructed to do so and in a manner prescribed by that officer;
4. She shall not own or possess any firearms or deadly weapons;


5. She shall not assault, harm, or threaten to assault or harm, any person;
6. She shall not intentionally modify her residence or employment without prior approval of her community corrections officer;
7. She shall not leave the State of North Carolina without the permission of the Director of the Community Corrections Section, North Carolina Department of Public Safety or his/her designee;

The conditions of this Order are limited to a term of three (3) years from the effective date of this Order. Compliance with the conditions of this Order shall be monitored by the North Carolina Department of Public Safety, Community Corrections Section and any violations shall be promptly reported to the Office of the Governor. If the Governor, or his successor, finds that APRIL LEIGH BARBER has violated any of the conditions herein provided, then the Governor or his successor may, in his or her discretion, revoke or modify the Commutation granted this day.

This Commutation Order shall not extend to any other offenses whereof the said APRIL LEIGH BARBER may be guilty.

This Commutation Order is signed this the 10th day of March, 2022, with an effective date of the 24th day of March, 2022.
