WHEREAS, on April 23, 2022, the Pamlico County Courthouse will open a time capsule that was buried on the courthouse property in 1972; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina is proud to recognize and celebrate the sesquicentennial anniversary of Pamlico County and all of their success;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim April 23, 2022, as **"PAMLICO COUNTY SESQUICENTENNIAL ANNIVERSARY"** in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
