PARDON FOR

PAUL ANDREW CREE

WHEREAS, Paul Andrew Cree, at the June 1979 Term of Surry County Superior Court, pled guilty to Common Law Robbery, Docket Number 79CRS2385, and was sentenced to a term of five (5) years, suspended for three (3) years with probation for three (3) years with the special condition that he serve an active sentence of sixty (60) days in the Surry County Jail; and

WHEREAS, Paul Andrew Cree now seeks a pardon from the Governor, in light of the circumstances surrounding his crime, his subsequent record and current need; and

WHEREAS, Paul Andrew Cree's record since this conviction has been one of responsible civic behavior and community service.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, in consideration of the above factors, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents PARDON the said Paul Andrew Cree, it being a full and unconditional Pardon. This Pardon shall not apply to any other offenses.
