COMMUTATION ORDER

FOR

## SETHY TONY SEAM

WHEREAS, SETHY TONY SEAM, at the September 1999 Term of Davidson County Superior Court, was convicted of First Degree Murder, Docket Number 97CRS021110, and by judgment of said Court was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole and at the October 2017 Term of Davidson County Superior Court was resentenced to life with the possibility of parole; and

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to me that this case is one fit for a Commutation.

**NOW**, **THEREFORE**, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents COMMUTE his sentence to time served subject to the following conditions:

- 1. He shall not commit any felony or Class A1 misdemeanor under the laws of the United States of America or any of its States or Territories;
- 2. He shall waive extradition to the State of North Carolina for any State of the United States of America or any of its Territories and will not contest any effort by any State or Territory to return him to the State of North Carolina in the event he violates any conditions of this Commutation Order;
- 3. He shall report promptly to his assigned probation/parole officer when instructed to do so and in a manner prescribed by that officer;
- 4. He shall not own or possess any firearms or deadly weapons;
- 5. He shall not assault, harm, or threaten to assault or harm, any person;
- 6. He shall not intentionally modify his residence or employment without prior approval of his probation/parole officer;

- 7. He shall not leave the State of North Carolina without the permission of the Deputy Secretary of Community Supervision, Department of Adult Correction or his/her designee;
- 8. He shall not intentionally contact the family of the victim without their consent.

The conditions of this Order are limited to a term of two (2) years from the date of this Order. Compliance with the conditions of this Order shall be monitored by the North Carolina Department of Adult Correction, Community Supervision Section and any violations shall be promptly reported to the Office of the Governor. If the Governor, or his successor, finds that SETHY TONY SEAM has violated any of the conditions herein provided, then the Governor or his successor may, in his or her discretion, revoke or modify the Commutation granted this day.

This Commutation Order shall not extend to any other offenses.

This Commutation Order is signed this the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of December 2024, with an effective date of the 6<sup>th</sup> day of January 2025.
