PARDON FOR

SHAVONA TANISHA CORBIN

WHEREAS, Shavona Tanisha Corbin, at the June 1997 Term of Cumberland County Superior Court, pled guilty to Possession with Intent to Manufacture, Sell/Deliver Cocaine, Manufacturing Cocaine, Maintaining a Place for the Keeping of Controlled Substances, and Conspiracy to Possess with Intent to Manufacture, Sell/Deliver Cocaine, Docket Number 96CRS035749, and as to each charge was sentenced to a minimum term of six (6) months and a maximum term of eight (8) months in the North Carolina Department of Correction, suspended for thirty-six (36) months with probation for thirty-six (36) months to run consecutively; and

WHEREAS, Shavona Tanisha Corbin now seeks a pardon from the Governor, in light of the circumstances surrounding her crimes, her subsequent record and current need; and

WHEREAS, Shavona Tanisha Corbin's record since these convictions has been one of responsible civic behavior and community service.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, in consideration of the above factors, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents PARDON the said Shavona Tanisha Corbin, it being a full and unconditional Pardon. This Pardon shall not apply to any other offenses.
