## PARDON OF FORGIVENESS ORDER

FOR

**WILLIAM SAMUEL FAGG, IV**

**WHEREAS**, William Samuel Fagg, IV, at the March 2003 Term of Wake County Superior Court, pled guilty to Possession with Intent to Sell/Deliver Cocaine, Docket Number 02CRS032563, and was sentenced to a minimum term of five (5) months and a maximum term of six (6) months in the North Carolina Department of Correction, suspended for twenty-four (24) months with probation for twenty-four (24) months with the special condition that he serve an active sentence of thirty (30) days; and

**WHEREAS**, William Samuel Fagg, IV now seeks forgiveness from the Governor, in light of the circumstances surrounding his crime, his subsequent record and current need; and

**WHEREAS**, William Samuel Fagg, IV's record since this conviction has been one of responsible civic behavior and community service.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, in consideration of the above factors, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents PARDON the said William Samuel Fagg, IV, it being a Pardon of Forgiveness. This Pardon shall not apply to any other offenses.
