## PARDON OF FORGIVENESS ORDER

FOR

**THURMAN VAN WALKER**

**WHEREAS**, Thurman Van Walker (“Walker”), at the April 1998 Term of Wake County Superior Court, pled guilty to Attempted Common Law Robbery, Docket Number 98CRS310, and Common Law Robbery, Docket Number 98CRS311, and was sentenced to a minimum term of thirteen (13) months and a maximum term of sixteen (16) months in the custody of the North Carolina Department of Correction, which was suspended and Walker was placed on probation for thirty (30) months; and

**WHEREAS**, Thurman Van Walker now seeks forgiveness from the Governor, in light of the circumstances surrounding his crime, his subsequent record and current need; and

**WHEREAS**, Thurman Van Walker’s record since these convictions has been one of responsible civic behavior and community service.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, in consideration of the above factors, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents PARDON the said Thurman Van Walker, it being a Pardon of Forgiveness. This Pardon shall not apply to any other offenses.
